Santa Goodwill Tour to Iceland in July 2022

Note: You can follow this itinerary by opening the following “driving map of Iceland” link. The color coded letters correspond to/near the locations on the tour.

See location

MON 18 July - Arrival day in Iceland. Airport pick up. Start the day at a local bakery for some pastries and coffee (refreshments on your own account). Sightseeing along the Reykjanes peninsula. See Bridge between two continents and several other attractions - who knows, maybe there will be a new volcanic eruption on the peninsula. Visit the Blue lagoon spa for a couple of hours. Basic entrance fee is US\$ 100 per person. Please note that the price is not a constant until the slot has been booked. Depends on the time of the day and demand. Works a bit like the price of an airline ticket. Drop off at your Reykjavik hotel in the afternoon, most likely around 4pm.

TUE 19 July - Day optional activities out of Reykjavik.

Fishing - Sea Anglin either 9 am or 1 pm - US\$ 150 p.p. Min 2 pax and max 14 pax. Equipment is included. The most commonly caught fish in the area is Catfish, Cod, Haddock, Mackerel and Pollock.

Fishing - Lake near Reykjavik. It takes about an hour to drive there. Trip may last from 9 am to 6 pm but can be much shorter if the group wishes (same price). Fishing license for the day US\$ 65 p.p. Lunchbox US\$ 55 p.p. Equipment rental US\$ 90 p.p. Guide with transport for the day who can take maximum 4 passengers US\$ 800.

Horse riding - Departure 10 am or 2 pm (pick up one hour earlier), US\$ 135 p.p. The ride itself is easy and takes 1.5 hours.

Sky lagoon - Spa 20 minute drive from Reykjavik city center. US\$ 60 to US\$ 120 depending on how much luxury you want.

Center Hotel Plaza (Reykjavik - **B** on map)

WED 20 July - Day tour Borgarfjörður valley 8 hours - to see the most prolific hot spring in Europe, scenic drive along Whale fjord - has relics from WWII and Iceland's only whale hunting station (not in use right now). See waterfall Hraunfossar and Barnafoss.

Optional activities this day...

- 1 - *Man-made Ice tunnel visit* (you're driven onto the glacier in a very large truck). US\$ 175 per person.
- 2 - *Visit the largest tubular lava cave In Iceland.* US\$ 75 per person.

Center Hotel Plaza (Reykjavik - **B** on map)

THU 21 July - Snæfellsnes peninsula tour 10 hours. To see coastline, maybe seáis, fishing towns, some lava fields and volcanic formations. National park Snæfellsjökull.

FRI 22 July - Depart Reykjavik for the south coast of Iceland including a visit to Vestmannaeyjar Island (weather permitting).
